Bids are hereby invited from suitable service providers for the development of a Land Use Management Scheme for Emadlangeni Municipality.

This bid will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system, as per revised Preferential Procurement Framework Act Regulations 2017.

Evaluation Criteria

Bidders must score 80% minimum to qualify for further evaluation.

Team Leader must hold tertiary qualification in Town and Regional Planning	20
Team Leader must be a registered Professional Town Planner by the SACPLAN in terms of the Planning Professions Act 2002	20
Key member of the team must have at least 5 years' practical experience in GIS	30
Team Leader must provide proof of appropriate experience in project management	10
Company must attach one example of a SPLUMA-compliant land use scheme	20

Bidders are required to submit original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their bids to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Failure to submit the proof of B-BBEE Certificate will result in forfeiture of points. Valid tax compliant status, proof of registration on central supplier database and company registration certificate should be attached. Service providers must be registered on the Municipality's Database.
