#### **Requirements:**

Reporting directly to the Civil Engineering Technician, the successful candidates will perform, among others, the following duties:

- a) Diagnosing faults through the application of visual and other related mechanical inspection and investigation procedures;
- b) Removing and replacing defective parts with re-conditioned or new spares;
- c) Cleaning and removing blockages or other forms of debris from inlets/ outlets restricting flow of fluid/ lubricants to movable parts and/ or replacing broken/ defective pipes;

- e) Checking the status of hydraulic driven mechanisms and communicating any malfunction to the immediate supervisor;

- j) Driving and testing vehicles to assess operating functionality and safety.
