



2023/2024 AMENDMENTS OF THE (SDBIP) DEPARTMENTAL SCORECARDS & TECHNICAL INDICATORS DESCRIPTIONS

EMadlangeni Local Municipality has amended the 2023/2024 SDBIP Departmental Scorecards and Technical Indicators Descriptions. The eMadlangeni Municipality seeks to inform the District Municipality (Amajuba) and the Local Provincial Government (COGTA) about the changes to be constituted in the Draft IDP. The Municipality is amending scorecard due to anticipated amendments to the Municipal budget, and new Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) proposed by Auditor General. Following the preparation and presentation of a Mid-year Budget and Performance Assessment Report, the management resolved that some existing KPIs need to be revised/reviewed to ensure they are within the available budget.

PURPOSE

To submit the proposed amendments to the 2023/2024 SDBIP Key Performance Indicators and Departmental Scorecards and TIDs. It must also be noted that the TIDs are amended because there are new KPIs in the amended scorecards, therefore the TIDs must be aligned with the scorecards KPIs and they are now approved by Council.

These changes emanate from Auditor General and also from Municipal Management following their preparation and presentation of the Section 72 Report.

DISCUSSION

Chapter 4 of the Municipal Systems Act no. 32 of 2000 Section 34(b), stipulates that the Municipal Council may amend its Integrated Development Plan in accordance with the prescribed process.

Chapter 7 of the Municipal Finance Management Act no. 56 of 2003 Section 54(c), states that the Mayor must consider and, if necessary, make any revisions to the Service Delivery and Budget Implementation Plan, provided that revisions to the service delivery targets and performance indicators in the plan may only be made with the approval of the Council following approval of an adjustments budget.

In terms of the Municipal Systems Act: Local Government Municipal Planning and Performance Management Regulations (2001), Regulation 3(4)(b) amendments to the IDP can only be approved by Council after the proposed amendments have been published for public comments for a period of at least twenty-one days.

The Department Scorecards forms part of the IDP and the SDBIP of the Municipality. Therefore, any changes made to improve the IDP will have to be reflected on the SDBIP as required by legislation.

Changes have been proposed to improve certain indicator definitions, and ensuring that these complement the manner in which targets have been phrased and or amended the 2023-2024 Departmental Scorecards. The changes are also made necessary by the proposed adjustments budget which will have an impact on current targets or service delivery projects that will have to be postponed to the following Financial Year depending on the budget allocation. All Departments were informed of the proposed changes and their inputs were sought out.

The proposed changes will also assist in improving the alignment of the Departmental Scorecards to the Auditor General requirements and various updated National Treasury definitions.

The updates will be published for public comments for a period of twenty-one days. Thereafter a Public Participation Report will be submitted together with the Departmental Scorecards to Council.
