Notice is given in terms of Section 41(4) of the National Water Act (the Act), 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) for a Water Use License Application (WULA) in terms of Section 40 of the Act

APPLICANT AND BACKGROUND:

Ikwezi Proprietary Limited operates under an approved mining right (Reference No. KZN30/5/1/2/2/297MR) issued in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act 28 of 2002) (MPRDA). Current operations comprise both opencast and underground mining activities. Ikwezi Mining Proprietary Limited wishes to include an additional area (Kromdraai and SVK2 pits), where opencast mining is planned into the existing mining operation. The proposed Kromdraai and SVK2 pits are located within the approved mining right boundary but was not historically applied for as part of their existing Water Use Authorisations.

Subsequently, Ikwezi Mining Proprietary Limited is in the process of applying for a new Water Use License (WUL) (Ref. no.: WU43689) on the remaining extent (RE) of the farm Struisvogel Kop 4275 HT and portion 3 of the farm Kromdraai 8626 HT. An EMPR Amendment was submitted in 2025 for the scope to be included in the Water Use License Application.

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 40 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998), that Ikwezi proposes to apply for various water uses as listed in Section 21 (Section 21 a, b, c, f, g, i and j) for the proposed opencast mining and related activities at the proposed mine.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION:

Ikwezi Mining Proprietary Limited is proposing to apply for a Water Use Licence (WUL) to undertake opencast coal mining at the Kromdraai and SVK2 pits and to construct, expand and operate both existing authorised and additional associated infrastructure within the approved Ikwezi Mining Right Area. The proposed activities include the development of opencast pits and box-cuts, in-pit sumps and dewatering pump stations with pipelines to existing Pollution Control Dams (PCDs), as well as clean stormwater catchment earth dams, clean and dirty water diversion channels, stormwater conveyance channels, contour and safety berms, energy dissipation structures, silt traps and sediment control facilities, stormwater management bund walls and spillway structures. Mining-related infrastructure will include existing and proposed run-of-mine (ROM) stockpile areas, overburden, discard and topsoil stockpiles, material handling and service platforms, and internal mine access and haul roads with associated culverts and road drainage structures. Supporting infrastructure will comprise existing and additional site camp facilities, contractor laydown and material staging areas, domestic water supply infrastructure linked to licensed boreholes, mobile ablution facilities and sewage handling systems connected to existing septic tanks, as well as temporary construction-phase infrastructure including erosion-control measures and instream diversion works.

The proposed Kromdraai and SVK2 pit areas are situated within the Dannhauser Local Municipality, in the Amajuba District of northern KwaZulu-Natal. The project area lies approximately 18 km south-east of Newcastle and about 35 km north-west of Dundee, within the Pongola-Mtamvuna Water Management Area quaternary catchment V32C (centre coordinate point: -27.852634°;30.093369°). The site is characterised by gently undulating to moderately sloping terrain, with ground elevations typically ranging between approximately 1 220 m and 1 325 m above mean sea level.
